History

Stanhope House was architecturally designed and built in 1867 by William Winter Irving. The Winter family owned large tracks of land in the area and Stanhope House was on 32,000 acres. Winter Irving built other houses for his sons on the property, Robgill, Bonshaw, Lauderdale. Stanhope House was sold in 1913 and in the 1990s the property (now known as Baker's Farm) was bought by Bonlac Foods.
