Archaeological Significance

The Former Bald Hills Hotel site is of low - medium archaeological significance. Parts of the site have been destroyed and ground disturbance around the tank and brick scatter is high. The site has the potential to provide further information about goldfields hotels and the development of services to support/ take advantage of passing gold fields traffic during the

mid 19th century.

Historical Significance The site is of local historical significance as a gold rush period hotel developed to meet the needs of travellers on their way to the goldfields. The site is also an important part of the development of Diggers Rest as the town grew around the establishment of hotel services.
