This site is located on the top of the terrace overlooking Werribee River. Located west side Werribee River, and north of Maltby Bypass. Site was former RAAF/USAFF construction workers' camp, during the construction and maintenance of Werribee Satellite Air Field. Nothing obviously historic is visible on the ground surface at this site. Distribution has happened through the construction of the Maltby Bypass.

Veterans Description for Public

Located on the top of the terrace overlooking Werribee River, on the west side and north of Maltby Bypass, was a former RAAF/USAFF construction workers' camp. The camp was established during the construction and maintenance of Werribee Satellite Air Field during the Second World War. Historic traces of the camp are no longer visible on the ground surface of the site and would have been distributed with the construction of the Maltby Bypass.
