The Maribyrnong Boom Gate and Guard Post Steps, on Chifley Drive, lead down to the waterline. A former guard post was located here and a boom gate was lowered every night at 6 pm during the Second World War, to prevent unauthorised access to the explosives factory further upstream until 6am each morning.
