Veterans Description for Public

Jacks Powder Magazine was built between 1875-76 and opened in 1878. By 1891, it was the largest and most important public magazine in the colony. Explosives from vessels in Hobson's Bay were transported upriver to Jack's Magazine, where they were unloaded onto barges at the entrance to the canal and/or proceeded 400 yards up the canal to offload at the canal loading dock, along Edgewater Boulevard. From here the explosives were offloaded onto a tramway that proceeded through a tunnel into the main explosives depot.
