The Army site map shows several water tanks on a low hill near the north-west corner of the West Bonegilla camp. They are listed as Army asset numbers 0462/228, 229, 230, and 231. Hyder shows a group of water tanks on a low hill at location 6 on Figure A5, and states that one is similar to a significant 'Manus' tank at Kapooka, NSW, but concludes the Bonegilla tank is incomplete and of no significance.

They are listed as Army asset numbers 0462/228, 229, 230, and 231.
