The Yarck World War One Memorial, on the Maroondah Highway, comprises of a marble statue of a Digger on a granite pillar with bluestone steps. The memorial is fenced by rough granite posts with metal chain. The memorial was erected by the people of Yarck, Kanumbra, Middle Creek, Gobur, Terip, Ruffy, Cathkin and Koriella.
