May be related to occupation of "the flat" area during the 1940s and 1950s. Site assessed as being of moderate scientific significance due to lack of similar sites in the area. May be of high cultural significance to the occupants of "the flat" area.

Interpretation of Site

Site reflects occupation of the area during the first half of the 20th-century. May be associated with occupation of "the flat" during the 1940s and 1950s by aboriginal people who left Cummeragunga mission as well as others who lived on "the flat" and Daish's paddock area. These areas are registered a an aboriginal historic place (AAV inventory 2.1-66). Alternatively, the site may reflect accumulated debris left by picnickers.
