The Rokewood War Memorial, located on Ferrars Street, consists of a flagpole on a granite base set within a paved circle. The memorial was originally erected to commemorate the First and Second World Wars, a plaque

was then added on June 25th 1989 by Victorian RSL State President Bruce Ruxton, to honour those men and women who served in Korea, Malaya, Borneo and Vietnam.
