Boer War Memorial 1901(moved from centre of street to its present position). Polished grey, pink and green granite with gold incised lettering. Columns, pediments, drinking fountain, lamp above.

Veterans Description for Public

The Violet Town Drinking Fountain and Lamp Post Memorial, at 35 Cowslip Street, was raised on public subscription in 1901 to commemorate the Boer War. The memorial is constructed from polished grey, pink and green granite with gold incised lettering.
