

### **Veterans Description for Public**

The Lake Charm Public Hall is located on the Murray Valley Highway. The entrance to the Hall grounds is marked by an arched granite gateway which reads "In Silent Tribute to Our Fallen." The gate pillars list the names of twelve locals who served in the First World War and and three who served in the Second World War.
