

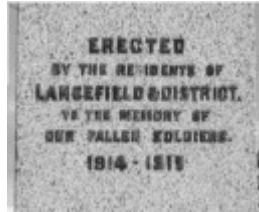

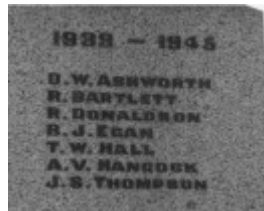

Physical Description 1

A granite Memorial with white marble soldier statue on top, which commemorates the fallen in World War I and World War II. It sits within an enclosure with pipe railing and rough granite posts and piers.

Veterans Description for Public

The Lancefield War Memorial, on High Street opposite the public hall, was erected to commemorate the First World War. The memorial comprises of a marble First World War Digger statue looking down, holding his rifle upside down in the funereal position, 'reserved arms.' The names of local soldiers who served in First and Second World Wars are listed on the base. In 2004, a plaque was added in memory of the men and women who served in Korea, Malaya, the Indonesian Confrontation, Vietnam, Gulf War, Afghanistan and Iraq and Peace Keeping missions.
