WERE WASHED FROM THE ROCKS WHILE FISHING; ONE BROTHER WAS DROWNED AND THE OTHER WAS SEVERLY INJURED, DYING SHORTLY AFTERWARDS. THE MEN DIED BETWEEN 1862 AND 1866. SANDSTONE HEADSTONE.
