LAURENCE HAYDEN INSTALLED A 5'3" GAUGE INCLINE TRAMWAY IN 1894 TO CONNECT WITH A GRADE LINE COMING OUT OF THE FIRM'S MILL ON WOMBAT CREEK. THE INCLINE OPERATED UNTIL 1896 WHEN IT WAS DESTROYED IN A BUSHFIRE.
