The Benalla RAAF Airfield and Camp, on Samaria Road,date from the Second World War. RAAF establishments were built throughout country Victoria during the war. The site was compulsorily acquired on 18th September 1941; it was utilised as an elementary flying school, then after the waras a camp by the Department of Immigration. The site currently houses flying clubs.
