The Meares House in Watsonia was requisitioned by the Army in 1938 for training purposes. In 1941 Army purchased the Meares House and the surrounding area was used as a medical training area and the house turned into a hospital. The area also included administration staff, a camp reception and transit camp for the troops. The area was given the official title of "Camp Q", but became known as "Watsonia Camp".
