STATE SIGNIFICANCE AGAINST CRITERIA A, C, D, F, G. THE HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE OF THESE SITES STEMS FROM THEIR ASSOCIATION WITH EARLY SETTLEMENT OF THE 1840S AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF HORSE BREEDING AND THE RACING INDUSTRY IN VICTORIA.

Interpretation of Site THE COBBLESTONE FLOOR WAS LIKELY A REMNANT OF THE FLOOR OF THE STABLES THAT WERE LOCATED IN THE AREA DURING THE REMOUNT PERIOD. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE STABLES WERE CONSTRUCTED AS A SIMPLE EARLY STABLE FOR THE FISHER STUD (1862-1890) PRIOR TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE EXTENSIVE STABLES NOW KNOWN AS THE FISHER STABLES.
