The Talbot Memorial, in the Soldier's Memorial Park, comprises of a polished black granite pillar and urn on a stone base. The memorial is specifically dedicated to a local soldier who fought in the Boer War, Robert Westrup Salmon. The inscription reads "*Erected by his friends in memory of Captain Robert Westrup Salmon VMR, 1st Victorian Contingent Staff Australian Regiment who died on service at Nauwnport S. Africa 16 March 1900.*" It originally stood outside the post office at the corner of Camp Street and Heales Street.
