The Portland War Memorial is located in a memorial reserve in civic precinct on Cliff Street, in front of the Portland Municipal Offices. The memorial is a white marble statue of a First World War soldier standing in the funereal position with his rifle upside down. The statue is elevated on a granite plinth with four red granite columns, which rises from a three-stepped stone base. On the stairs leading up to the Memorial, plaques have been added for the Second World War, Korea, Vietnam and Malaya conflicts.
