The memorial at Wickliffe is a variant on the traditional obelisk. In contrast to Port Campbell and Terang, it tops the obelisk with an orb. The laurel wreath, a classical symbol of victory, is added the column.

The Wickliffe War Memorial Pillar commemorates the First World War with the inscription "In Honor of the Brave Men Of This District Who Fought For Freedom Honor & Justice", and a list of the soldiers names beneath. An inscription has been added to the base for the soldiers of the district who served in the Second World War. The pillar is topped by an orb and a laurel wreath, a classical symbol of victory tops the column.
