The Ascot Vale West monument is a granite obelisk located in Victory Memorial Park. It was established on April 30th 1922 and lists the names of 71 fallen and returned soldiers from the Boer War, First World War, Second World War, British Commonwealth Ocuupation Force in Japan (BCOF), Korea, Malaysia and Vietnam.
