The Beulah Memorial Gates serve as the entranceway to the sports ground in Deakin Street. They comprise of large stone pillars with wrought iron gates. Built in 1928, the gates list the names of eighty-six fallen and returned soldiers of the First World War. There is also a small rock monument at the centre of the gates with a plaque for the Second World War, Korea and Vietnam.
