## **Veterans Description for Public**

The Chatsworth War Memorial is situated in a small reserve in the centre of the now relatively dormant township of Chatsworth, at a site known locally as 'Fiveways.' The memorial comprises of an obelisk dedicated to those who fought in the First World War and was erected c.1920s. The Memorial is enclosed with a wire fence but is unfortunately in poor condition.
