The Essendon War Memorial, located in Queen's Park, is a tall sandstone monument established on April 25th 1929 in memory of the First World War. It was then rededicated to all individuals who served in the Second World War, Korea, Malaya, Borneo, Vietnam and peacekeeping missions.
