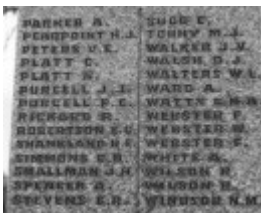

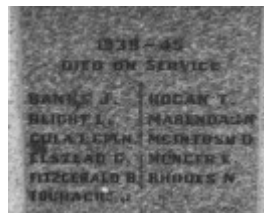

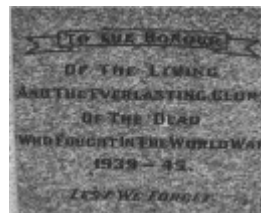

The Ballan War Memorial, outside the Post Office, consists of a column and ball monument. Unveiled on March 27th 1920, it lists the names of three hundred and thirty-seven fallen and returned soldiers. The memorial commemorates those who served in the First World War, Second World War, Korea, Malaya, Borneo and Vietnam.
