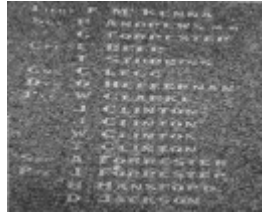

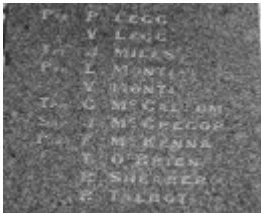

The Taradale War Memorial is a grey granite obelisk, surrounded by a rock pillar and steel chain fence. Located in Mineral Springs Park, one hundred metres east of the Calder Highway, it commemorates the service of the citizens of Taradale in the First and Second World Wars, listing them by name and rank. A lone bronze plaque has been added for Private J.C. Boyer who served in Vietnam.
