The Great Ocean Road Arch Memorial marks the start of the road and commemorates those who fought in the First World War. The arch is constructed from timber logs and stone pillars. All along the Great Ocean Road, are numerous structures that honour the memory of those who lost their lives fighting the First World War and in subsequent conflicts. The Road was built over 13 years by up to 3000 returned soldiers.
