## Veterans Description for Public

The Nathalia War Memorial, on Blake and Weir Streets, is a white marble statue mounted on a grey granite columned pedestal, dedicated to the First and Second World Wars. In front of the statue are two polished grey granite slabs resting on a stone flagstone base. The statue resembles a First World War digger standing easy, holding the barrel of a rifle and leaning against a tree trunk. The pedestal is inscribed with the names of those who served and the main inscription reads, "*In Memoriam. 'We sleep in many lands that you may live.' Nathalia District Memorial. The Great War 1914-1918. In memory of those who gave their lives for God, King and Country. 1939-1945.*"
