#### **Veterans Description for Public**

The Nathalia War Memorial, on Blake and Weir Streets, is a white marble statue mounted on a grey granite columned pedestal, dedicated to the First and Second World Wars. In front of the statue are two polished grey granite slabs resting on a stone flagstone base. The statue resembles a First World War digger standing easy, holding the barrel of a rifle and leaning against a tree trunk. The pedestal is inscribed with the names of those who served and the main inscription reads, "In Memoriam. 'We sleep in many lands that you may live.' Nathalia District Memorial. The Great War 1914-1918. In memory of those who gave their lives for God, King and Country. 1939-1945."
