The Sandford War Memorial, located on the corner of Burke Street and the Henty Highway, is a granite monument obelisk, commemorating the First and Second World Wars. On each face the names of soldiers who served are listed. The inscriptions read, "In Loving Remembrance of Sandford Men who fought in The Great War 1914-19" and "In Honor of the Men of Sandford who Answered Their Country's Call 1939-45." A plaque was added to commemorate those who served in the Korean War and Vietnam War.
