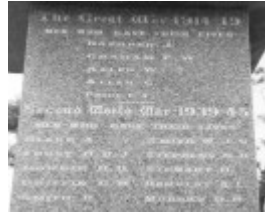

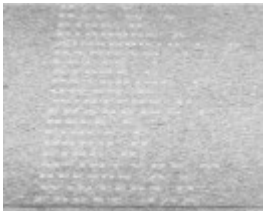

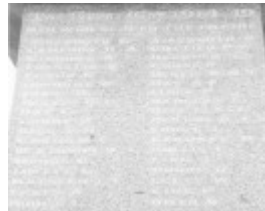

The Heywood War Memorial, on Hunter Street, comprises of an obelisk mounted on a granite plinth and surrounded by a concrete post fence. The Memorial includes the names of those who served in the First and Second World Wars. There is also a dedication to those who served in conflicts between 1950- 1973, including Korea, Malaya, Sabah-Sarawak, Malayan Peninsula and Vietnam.
