The Mansfield Obelisk, located on the High Street, commemorates the Boer War. The memorial comprises of a granite obelisk, specifically dedicated to the memory of Herbert John Goodman. The inscription notes he was "*killed in action at Kostevo River, South Africa July 22nd 1900, whilst honourably upholding the prestige of Queen and Empire. 'No Surrender.'*"
