#### **Veterans Description for Public**

The Watchem War Memorial, located on the corner of Hoban Street and Sunraysia Street, comprises of a digger soldier. A gold lettered inscription reads "Erected By The Residents of Watchem and District in Honor of their Fallen and Returned Soldiers in The Great War 1914-1919. Their Name Liveth For Evermore." Beneath is a list of the soldiers' names. An inscription with the names of Second World War servicemen has also been added.
