The Greta Boer War Memorial, located inside the Greta Cemetery, comprises of a marble, broken column monument. The money for the monument was raised on public subscription and is specifically dedicated to the memory of Private William Petty. Petty died in Pretoria, South Africa on December 27th 1900, aged 23. The epitaph reads; " A Good Comrade and a Brave Soldier."
