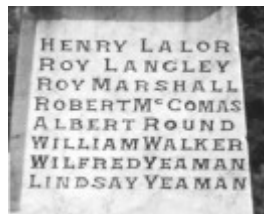

The Montrose War Memorial erected in 1921, on Mt Dandenong Tourist Road, is a marble obelisk commemorating the First and Second World Wars. The memorial lists a 100 names of fallen and returned soldiers from the Montrose district.
