The Lilydale War Memorial, on the Maroondah Highway and Clarke Street, commemorates the First and Second World Wars. It comprises of a stone obelisk column listing the names of local soldiers who served.

The cannon, in front of the memorial, is thought to have been cast in 1843 and used aboard the HMVS Nelson. It was acquired by the Shire of Lillydale to celebrate the opening of the town's water supply in 1905. However, its origins are disputed.
