

## **Veterans Description for Public**

The Hepburn Mineral Springs Memorial Gates, on Tenth Street and Park Avenue, comprise of a granite archway and a large cross marked out the grounds of the park. The gateway is dedicated to the men of the district who gave their lives in the First World War, Second World War, Korea, Malaya and Vietnam. The right pillar reads "Glory Guards With Solemn Arms the Bivouac of the Dead, Their Name Liveth For Evermore."
