CARAVAN PARK EXISTED ON THE SITE FROM THE 1960S(?) UNTIL SEPTEMBER 2003. THE WESTERN AREA OF THE BLOCK HOWEVER WAS NOT USED FOR ONSITE VANS WHICH FILLED THE REMAINDER OF THE AREA. ORIGINAL BLOCK APPEARS ON A PARISH COUNTY PLAN OF PAYWIT AND SUB-DIVIDED BY 1859 (GEELONG HERITAGE CENTRE, PLAN B115).
