SHOWN ON THE 1855 PLAN AS TWO BUILDINGS SET BACK ON LOT 1 SECTION V TOWNSHIP OF FOOTSCRAY OWNED BY HENDY HELLYER. BY 1864 THE SITE CONTAINED FOUR BUILDINGS FRONTING MORELAND AND NAPIER STREETS. THE 1875 PLAN HOWEVER SHOWS ONLY TWO BUILDINGS ON THE SITE. THE 1895 AND 1910 MMBW PLANS SHOW THE CURRENT BUILDING WITH A SERIES OF LONG WOODEN AND BRICK BUILDINGS AT THE REAR.
