One of the few sites in the region indicating domestic/pastoral history. May indicate development of local industries supplying the region and influx of gold miners.

Interpretation of Site	The site appears to be a cellar. Given the region and local industry, it may have been used as a dairy cellar for milk and cream. The cellar's large size (12x5m) indicates that it may have been used for commercial purposes - perhaps for the supply of the nearby town of Wedderburn.
