The site is of local historical significance. No history of the site is known at this stage, however. It has high archaeological potential and significance. Further investigations are required.

Interpretation of Site	Part of the two-roomed house was likely made from timber as indicated by the footings on the western side. The building with the chimney was likely a kitchen although the hearth is very narrow for a kitchen fireplace. The third and smallest building was perhaps a store-room. The site is probably the remains of a farming complex.
