History

Robert and Susan Bridle selected land in the early 1880s, while Robert was a teamster. They were both outstanding horse riders. They eked out a living by making their selection more or less self supporting. The main sources of actual cash income were from the bullock team operations, including carting wattle bark and general stock work. They bartered freely with their neighbours. Robert and Susan raised a family of 10 children. The site where they are buried was gazetted a cemetery reserve in 1906, but found to be unsuitable for the purpose. The Bridles are the only people buried there.
