History

The graves are reportedly of the three Johansson children (unnamed). Two children are buried in the larger grave, and one in the smaller. This is indicative but not conclusive of the devastation caused by childhood illnesses or epidemics of earlier times. The history of the graves is not documented, and the story of the Johanssons comes from a Mr Herbert Bennett, 86 years old in 2003, who lived at Jericho in 1931. The story needs further investigation.
