History

Frederick Gay, described as a pauper, committed suicide aged 65 years by shooting himself, at Toongabbie in 1905. Because of the circumstances of his death, he was buried outside the Toongabbie Cemetery, in a paddock once owned by J T O'Meara. The present monument was erected by Arthur Tanner of the Toongabbie Cemetery Trust, replacing an earlier wooden pole marker.
