History

John Riddell was a former owner of Gillingall Station. Born in Scotland, he died of natural causes aged 79 years at Gillingall, on 21 September 1891. His wife Margaret was born at Galashiels, and married John at Lauder, Berwickshire, Scotland. She died at Gillingall on 13 December 1880, aged 64 years, from a bout of influenza. The couple had migrated to the colony in about 1856. They were survived by 5 children.
