History

Henley's Landing and boat shed are still evident on this site situated on the river banks of Maribyrnong Park. This area was a popular picnic spot, with boats for hire, a band rotunda, and adjacent rowing regatta grandstands. The park was first proclaimed in 1906 and was the first official park on the Maribyrnong. Promenading was popular in the area, and a bandstand and tearooms were located in the area.
