Site appears to preserve some intact features and deposits assocated with a nineteenth century stables and dairy that provides information on rural occupations of the area. Some stone imported from locals sources. The archaeology can provide information on the intensity and scope of rural settlement in this area.

Site appears to be a fairly large dairy and stables complex with extensive cobbling (granite and silcrete) some of which may have formed an access road. Foundations of a building with one course of unprepared granite remaining - some wall alignments completed robbed. Some patches of crushed brick (bricks not machine made) and 19c artefact deposits. Preliminary interpretation suggests that the site abandoned by early 20c at latest and probably relates to early rural occupation in this area.
