and John Street / Bassett Road (west) in three blocks. Mrs Dorbin purchased the 50 acres east of Bassetts Road. By 1920 a building is shown as present on Cookes Road in this location. A building is also shown in 1935, at the same time as buildings are shown at the northern end of property, off north end of Bassetts Road.
