## Statement of Significance

Last updated on - May 11, 2006

The O'Halloran & Hare farmhouse site is of local significance for its associations with the early settlement of the Hazelwood area during the selection era in the late nineteenth century. It illustrates how farms were developed and is of particular interest for the surviving domed wells which are rare examples within the study area.

Interpretation of Site	The O'Halloran and Hare farmhouses, now situated within Mathison Park, comprises the ruins of buildings, wells and remnant trees associated with the use of this land as a farm by the O'Halloran and Hare families between c1880 and 1960.
