Physical Description 1

The front section of this brick house would appear to date from the late 1860's from its flat pitched roof and the cast iron pattern of the verandah. The verandah frieze iron is one of rosettes and discs set into a criss-cross pattern which is also found in South Drummond Street, Carlton, and here it is divided by a horizontal timber member which also indicates an early date. The frieze is supported by cast iron brackets which also appear to be from the 1860s on chamfer-stopped timber posts. The house has three light bay windows and a central narrow doorway facing Sturt Street, with paired eaves brackets below the roof. The rear section would appear to be a later addition, possibly from the 1880s. This pleasantly proportioned, possible early building, with an interesting verandah form, is an important element in the streetscape (*Ballarat Conservation Study*, 1978).
